

## ADI Part 1 Theory Test: REVISION PLAN

Tick the boxes once you've completed each task

**Follow this revision plan, as laid out below, to fully prepare for the ADI part 1 theory test.**

Study for 30-45 minutes **every day**, over a 6-8 week period, to properly prepare for this test.

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**Firstly, read the following two books plus the Band 3 & Band 4 revision notes to build solid, foundational knowledge.**

- The Highway Code
- The Official DVSA Guide to Driving the essential skills
- Band 3 & Band 4 revision notes (available on request: send Jonathan an email)

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**Next, read the following DVSA information, again building solid, foundational knowledge.**

- Read and understand the **DL25 driving test report form** (*PDF available on website*). You need to be familiar with this form.
- Read (on the .gov website) **'Carrying out driving tests: Examiner Guidance'**  
This is the guidance driving examiners follow when they carry out driving tests in Great Britain. It's sometimes known as the 'DT1'. Read this guidance to understand the processes that driving examiners follow and how they make decisions about faults made in driving tests.  
**Note:** You only need to read sections – 1, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 14.
- Read (on the .gov website) **'Approved driving instructor (ADI) code of practice'**

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**Now it's time to practice theory questions from the Driving Test Success: Theory Test app.**

- Car driver in GB (learner driver questions)



To begin with, practice some multiple choice 'mock tests' for car drivers (learner driver questions). Make sure **'Car Driver'** is selected in the question bank. This is a great way to boost your knowledge. Each mock test has 50 questions. You should be getting every question correct. Keep practicing until you're consistently getting 50/50 for each mock test.

## Now practice some revision questions for the ADI part 1 theory test.



- ADI Instructor questions (Trainee ADI in GB)

Moving onto revision questions for the ADI part 1 theory test.  
Make sure '**ADI Instructor**' is selected in the question bank

- Band 1- Road Procedure. Practice all questions.
- Band 2 - Traffic signs, pedestrians, car control, mechanical knowledge. Practice all questions
- Band 3 – Driving test, disabilities, the law. Practice all questions.
- Band 4 – Publications and Instructional techniques. Practice all questions.

Once you've answered all of the above questions, move onto practicing some mock tests.

- Mock Tests

You need to be scoring at least 96/100 before you attempt your actual Part 1 theory test. You can't drop below 20 out of 25 in any of the 4 bands. So focus your studying on whichever band is your weakest.

**Note:** These National Standards can feel a bit heavy when you first open them — they are worth reading, but take your time. You **don't need to memorise them** for your Part 1 test, so don't let them overwhelm you at this stage.

Go through them in your own time, and remember — you can keep referring back to them as you progress through **Part 2, Part 3, and into your ADI career**. They're a great resource to dip back into whenever you need them.

For now, just focus on understanding the basics and don't put pressure on yourself to absorb everything all at once.

You're doing the right thing by starting to read them — just don't let them overload you early on!



Once you've completed all of the above, you'll be fully prepared for the multiple-choice questions in the ADI part 1 theory test.

## Let's get ready for the Hazard Perception test!



### Hazard perception practice

- Watch the hazard perception video on the Boom website (or on the Boom YouTube channel)  
This is a video tutorial showing you how to pass the hazard perception test.
- Practice hazard perception clips on the Driving Test Success: Theory test app.
  - There are 34 CGI clips and 51 real-life videos. Practice all of these.
  - Select 'Trainee ADI' and practice 'Mock Tests'.

You'll be prepared for the hazard perception test once you're averaging 4 out of 5 for each scorable hazard. The pass mark is 57 out of 75. You'll pass the hazard perception test providing you get 4 out of 5 for each scorable hazard (which would be an overall score of 60 out of 75).

**Once you've completed all of the above, you'll be ready to take the ADI Part 1 theory test!**
